Special guest speaker the Hon. Carolyn Bennett joins Waypoint's Annual Report to the Community to share the current landscape of mental health and addictions in Canada and the realities brought on by the COVID pandemic.

Minister Bennett previously served as Minister of Crown-Indigenous Relations, Minister of Indigenous and Northern Affairs, and Minister of State for Public Health. Prior to her election in 1997 in the Toronto-St. Paul's riding, Minister Bennett was a family physician and an Assistant Professor in the Department of Family and Community Medicine at the University of Toronto. In 2003, she received the first-ever Champion of Mental Health Award from the Canadian Alliance on Mental Illness and Mental Health.
